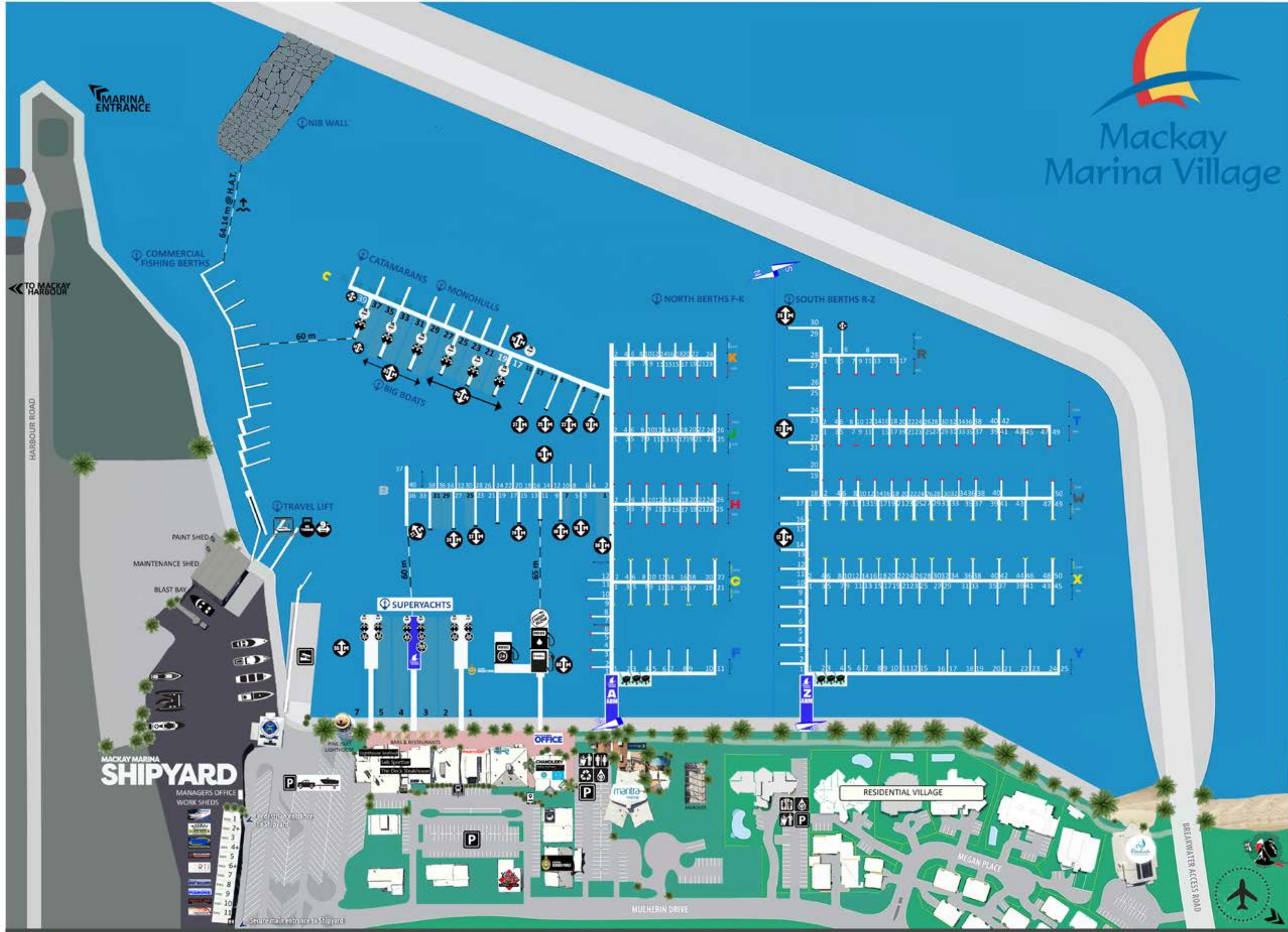

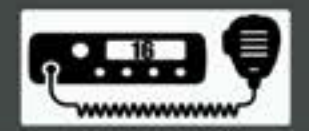
You can get a haircut, or a tattoo or go on an island hop with Wild Cat.

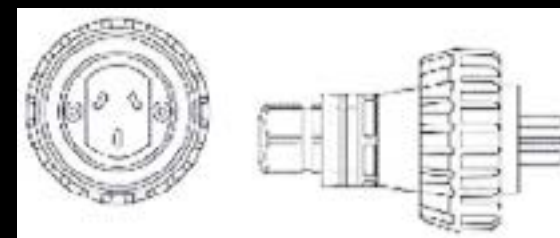

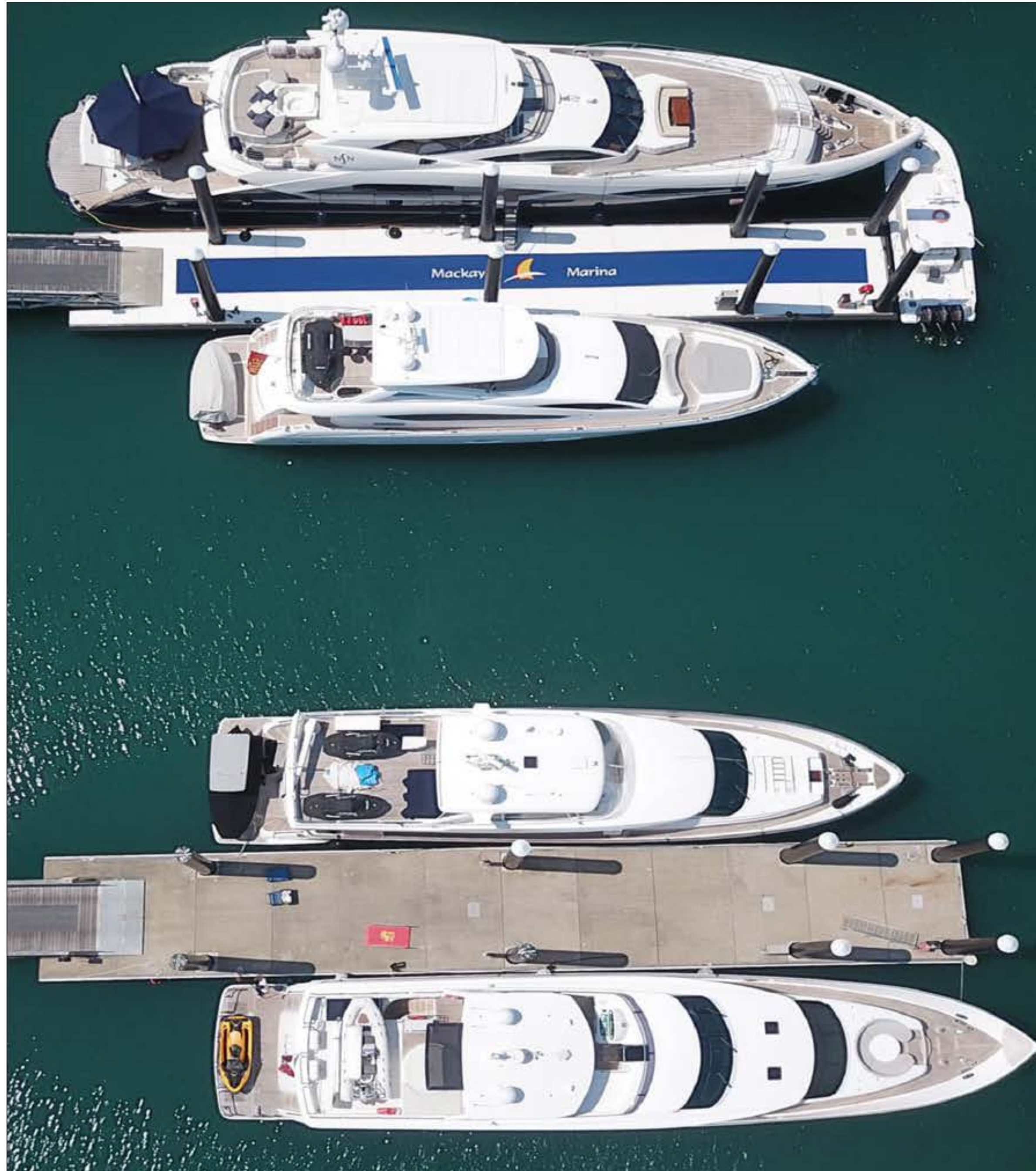

Looking to plot a course with something a little different? Base your yacht at the marina for the season and create unique, action-packed itineraries tailored to each charter.

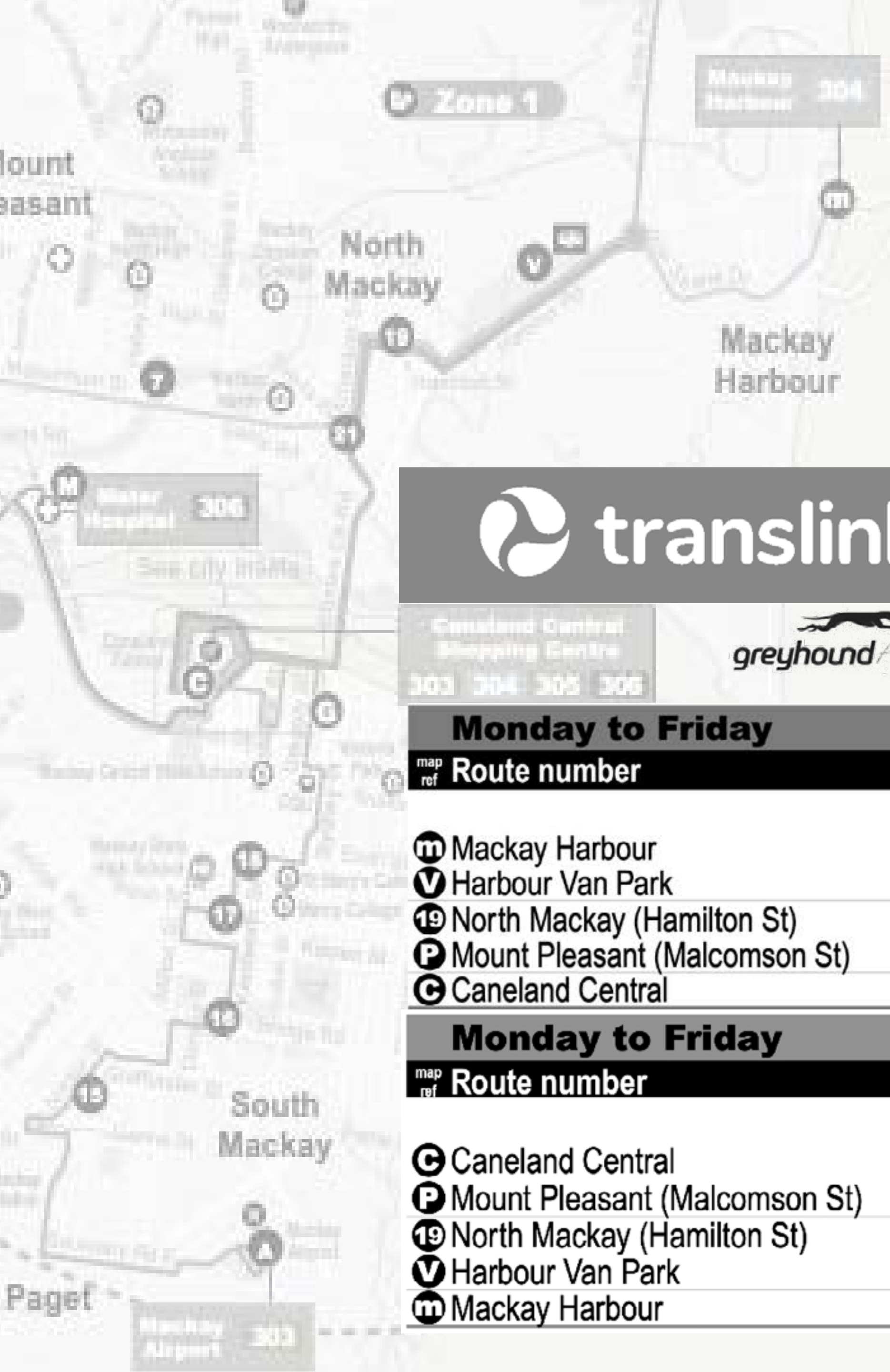
Think sun-soaked days cruising turquoise seas and dipping below the surface of hidden coves. Dive ancient Pleistocene reefs and shipwrecks, keep your eyes peeled for olive sea snakes, moray eels and manta rays. Get your thumb flippers ready to signal your loggerhead, hawksbill, and green turtle sightings as they glide through the clear waters.

Watch cetaceans such as dolphins and porpoises play on the bow or dugong frolicking near the inner reef. After a summer of feeding on krill in Antarctic waters, whales head north for winter to mate and have their babies. Queensland's sub-tropical temperatures and calm waters are ideal from June to see humpback and pilot whales on the world's largest and oldest annual migration. Watch from the aft deck as the pods play and breach in the distance, mothers feeding their calves, and young whale males on their first solo trip without big muma!

Very far offshore lies the huge underwater blue hole, skilled divers will find birdsnest corals (seriatopora) and super elongated staghorn corals submerged at around 20 metres in the deep blue caverns.

Embark on an on-land adventure on offshore unspoilt tropical islands, exploring melaleuca forests, native grass trees, exposed headlands, and sandstone cliffs. On the mainland share a beach and sunrise with roos, freshwater scuba dive in a subtropical rainforest with a paddle of platypuses then hike and chase waterfalls in gorges.

With its palm-fringed esplanade, clean facilities and friendly team, Mackay Marina is the perfect launch pad to explore the islands of the Mackay Region. Unravel the unique, natural wonders above and below the ocean off the coast, cruise to Cockermouth, Keswick, Brampton, St Bees, and Scawfell islands.

The port entrance is suited to all tides and has deep-water access.

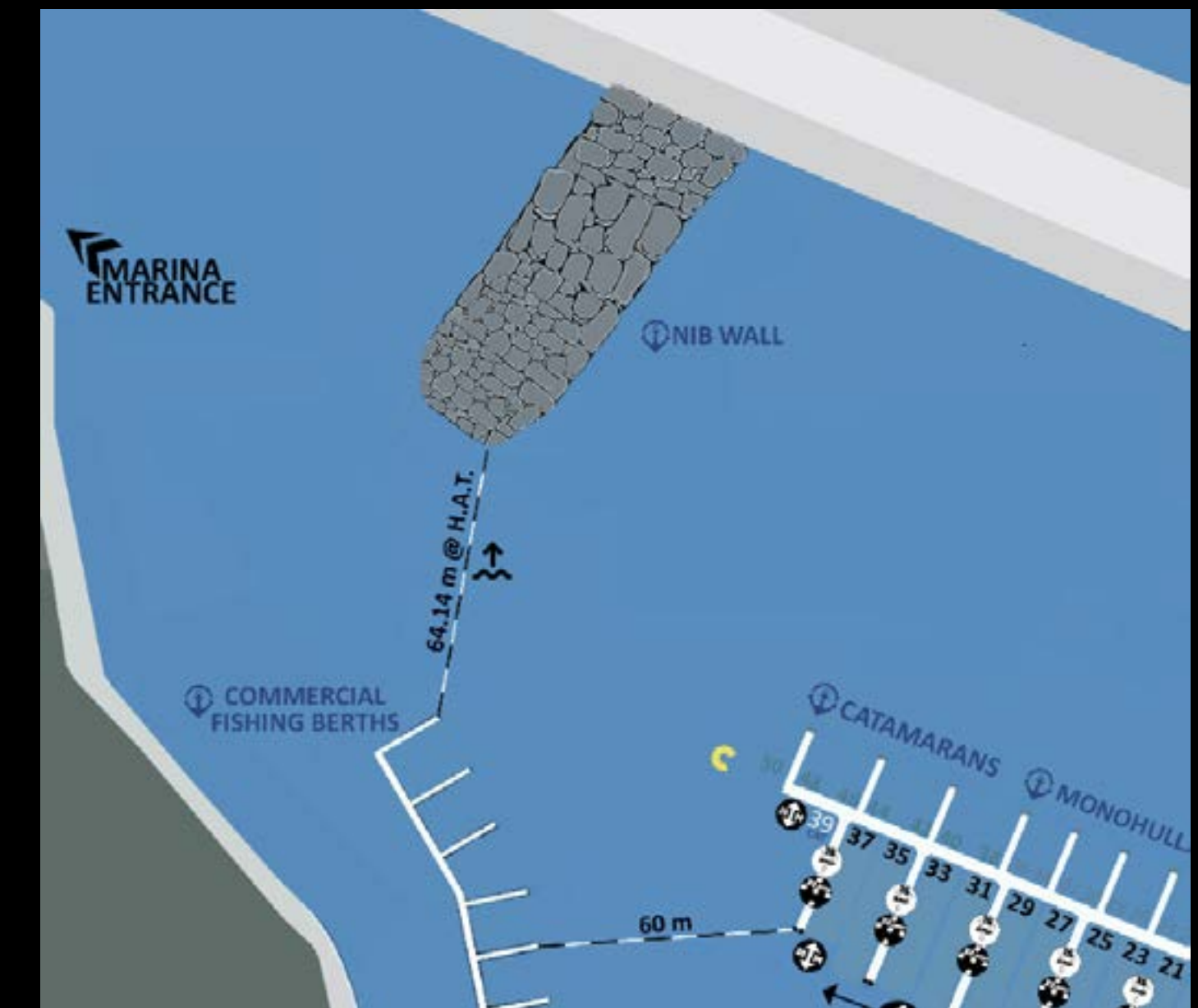

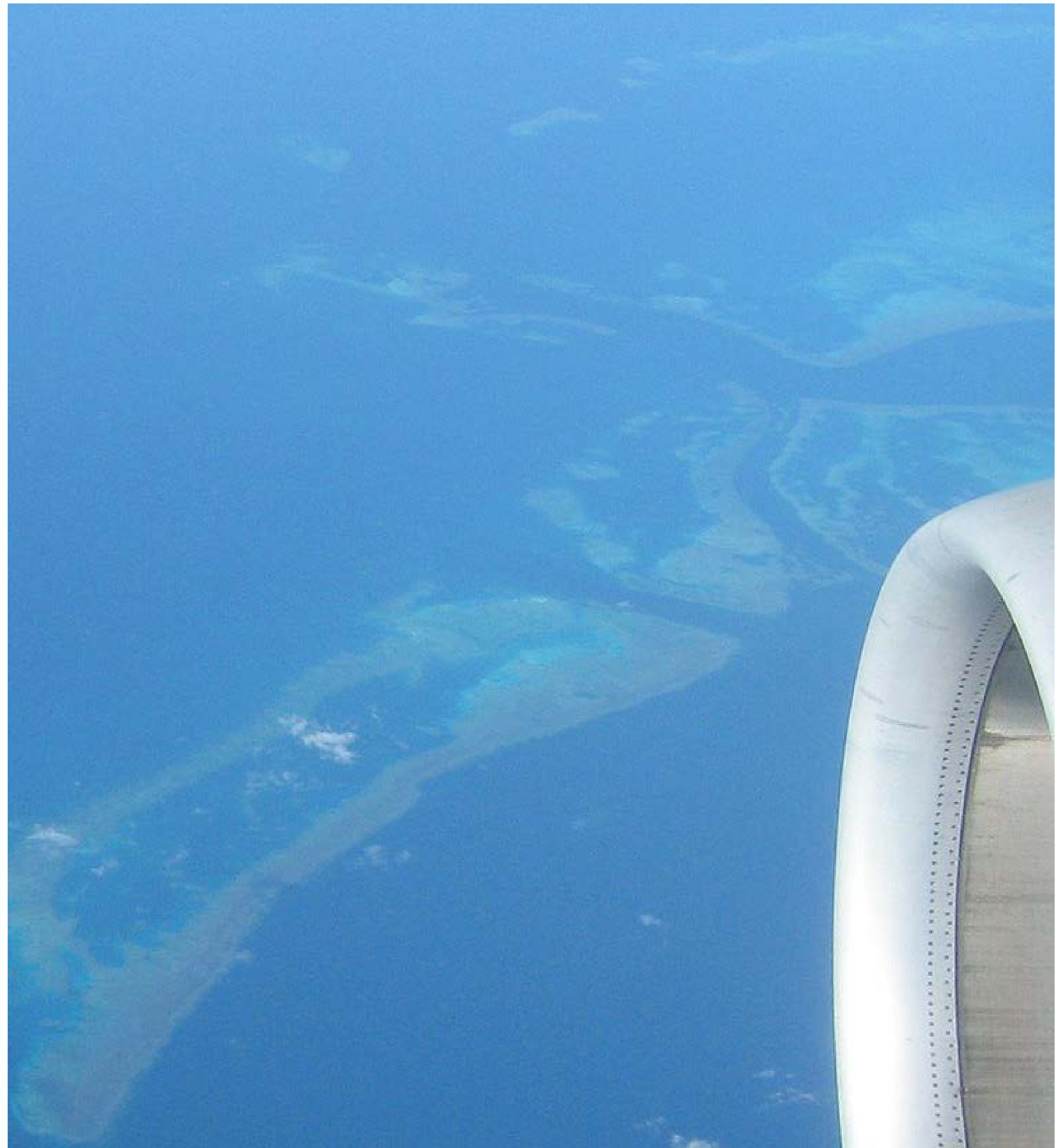
